4.1.5	From the 15 th May 2024 the Ramblers Walk Leader Guidance requires any potential/new walk leaders to complete three mandatory elements. These are outlined in the Chair's report. The online mandatory elements are monitored by Ramblers and Central Office. When the system detects that a volunteer has undertaken them it will automatically certify that the required modules have been completed.	MD
	Volunteers can also complete the mandatory elements offline as part of an ECR training workshop. This allows the ECRs' Membership Secretary to advise CO that the volunteer has completed the required elements. The new walk leader is then certified by the Ramblers and is able to lead walks.	MS
	MD to type list of Walk Leaders which will be circulated to Walk Coordinators for editing in due course. MS shared ECRs analysis of the 'Musts' 'Shoulds' and 'Coulds' of the new Walk Leader Guidance and recommendations for ECR going forward. The document will be attached to the minutes.	
4.1.6	Apps Training is scheduled for 18 th July '24 at Macclesfield Tennis Club.	Note

Although members can presently plan a walk using ECR's walks planner, there may have to be some changes in the future in the arrangement with Ordnance Survey mapping. Investigation of the arrangement North and Mid Cheshire may have with Ramblers route planning would be useful; MS to ask Roger Fielding if he can contact N&MC.	MS
